Should manatees be present in any race or regatta area, the event must be delayed or stopped until the animals are clear of the area.

Approval does not confer release from any ordinance or regulation imposed by local or civil authority having jurisdiction in the area concerned. No restrictions are placed on the use of these navigable waters by other interested parties.
