The Commanding Officer of NAS Jacksonville has agreed to allow Navy Jacksonville Yacht Club to act as the host for visiting members of other yacht clubs who will be attending this year's Air Show.

If you will be arriving by boat, the following criteria **must** be followed, to the letter, in order for your members to take part in this event.

1. First come first served, only 15 Boats (Sail or Power) will be able to berth at the Mulberry Cove Marina.
2. All boats will be berthed within the Mooring Field.
3. All vessel owners must provide proof of liability insurance and registration.
4. All vessel owners must go into Mulberry Cove Marina to complete a Marina Transient contract and make payment for one night stay. (\$6. buoy, \$8.40 wet slip).
5. Owners of vessels must provide picture ID.
6. Transient space for wet slip is limited to:
 - a. The outside face of F-pier and T-pier.
7. Transient space for buoys is limited to:
 - a. Those buoys that do not already have harnesses attached.
8. "Rafting up" of vessels on buoys and piers is **prohibited**.
9. Vessel owners and guests are limited to the NJYC property, the Mulberry Cove Marina property, and the General Public Area for the Air Show.
10. NJYC personnel will provide all transportation to and from the General Public Area for the Air Show.
11. All boaters must dinghy in and use dock space close in to shore. **Do not** dock on the floating dock between the boat launch ramps.

The US Coast Guard, as they should, will be in charge of Security on the St. Johns River. They will pass the word on places to anchor and off-limits areas. Their fleet will stage out of Mulberry Cove Marina.

We hope you will take advantage of this unique opportunity to join us. What a great way to show your support for the military and their families.
