NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES: The regatta will be governed by the 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing, the current rules of the J-24 Class Association, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. This regatta is classified ISAF advertising code Category C, Appendix 1.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 The regatta is open to J-24's class yachts that meet with the current class rules and who complete registration.

2.2 This is an **advance registration event** either by mail, fax or e-mail. The Florida Yacht Club must receive the entry form not later than Wednesday, November 3, 2006. Entries received after this date will incur a late entry fee (\$20.00).

2.3 An entry form is available on the Fleet 55 web site at www.j24fleet55.com.

2.4 Return completed entry forms to Scott Gaines, Harbormaster, The Florida Yacht Club, 5210 Yacht Club Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32210.

2.5 If the entry form is received on or before Wednesday, November 8th, the entry fee can be paid at registration without incurring the late entry penalty.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration/Check in.

6. COURSE: The course will be windward/leeward as described in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used. If six races or more are completed the worst race will be thrown out. One race will constitute a regatta. The Scoring Penalty (RRS 44.3) shall apply.

8. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers.

9. INSPECTION: A current valid J/24 Class Measurement Certificate must be presented at registration. Sails may be subject to inspection before the racing begins.

10. LODGING. Suggested hotels include the Days Inn (904) 269-8887 and the Holiday Inn (904) 264-9513. Both are located in Orange Park on U.S. 17 approximately 10 minutes South of FYC.
