- 2.3 All boats shall have their numbers on the mainsail, spinnakers, and each headsail having an LP measurement exceeding 130% of the base of the foretriangle.

- 7. COURSE: The race course will be announced at the competitors' meeting.
- **8. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except that each yacht's series score will be the total of all her scores (no throw-outs). A minimum of one race will constitute a regatta.
