## **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1. RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.(RRS) 2005-2008.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of US SAILING and by the Sailing Instructions.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 PHRF Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Cruiser classes, and One-Design Classes.
- 2.2 All boats competing in PHRF classes must have a valid PHRF rating.
- 2.3 All PHRF boats shall have their sail numbers on the mainsail, spinnakers, and each headsail having a LP measurement exceeding 130% of the base of the foretriangle.
- 2.4 One-Design boats will race under the rules for their class.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the FCSA Standard Entry Form copy found on <a href="www.sailjax.com">www.sailjax.com</a>, or fill one out on race day at the club.

#### 4. FEES

- **4.1** PHRF \$30.
- **4.2** One-Design Classes \$10.

#### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at 0930 on race day. Changes to this notice or the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the exterior bulletin board by 1000 on race day.

#### 6. VENUE

6.1 The racing area will be in the St. Johns River as depicted on NOAA Chart 11492 between the Buckman Bridge to the south and the Fuller Warren Bridge to the north.

#### 7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be as shown in the Sailing Instructions and displayed on the committee boat.

#### 8. PENALTY SYSTEM

**8.1** Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

#### 9. SCORING

- **9.1** The Low-point Scoring System, Appendix A, Rule A4.1 of the racing rules, will apply for this regatta.
- **9.2** Results will be posted at NJYC and on www.sailjax.com.

#### 10. PRIZES

10.1 First, second, and third place prizes will be awarded in all classes. All competitors competing in the FCSA Fall Series will be scored in their respective class.

#### 11. BASE PASSES

11.1 A person form NJYC will be at the Yorktown Gate (main gate) from 9:30 to 10:30 am the day of the race to help with base entrance. All <u>persons</u> entering the base must have a picture ID. All <u>vehicles</u> must have and provide proof of current registration and insurance.

#### 12. INFORMATION

- **12.1** Social and awards after the race. Dock on the southern face of F Dock which is the first dock as you approach Mulberry Cove Marina from the east.

# SAILING INSTRUCTIONS PHRF FLEET

#### 1 RULES

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing*.

The following prescriptions of US Sailing, by the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race.

#### 2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board(s) located at NJYC sliding glass doors on river side of the club house.

#### 3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1100 on the day it will take effect.

#### 4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

**4.1** Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flag pole river side of Club House.

#### 5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

**5.1** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12:00 PM.

#### 6 CLASS FLAGS

**6.1** Class flags will be announced at the 1100 Sailors Meeting in the club house.

#### 7 RACING AREAS

7.1 The racing area will be in the St. Johns River between the Buckman Bridge to the south and Fuller Warren Bridge to the north as depicted on NOAA Chart 11492.

#### 8 THE COURSES

8.1 The race course will be posted at the 1100 Sailors Meeting in the club house.

#### 9 MARKS

9.1 All government marks in the racing area may be used along with race mark "E" and set marks as described at the 1100 Sailors Meeting in the club house.

#### 10 THE START

10.1 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal.

- 10.2 The start line will be between an orange flag on the portside of the race committee boat at the starboard end of the line and the orange float at the port-end.
- 10.3 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.

#### 11 THE FINISH

- 11.1 The finish line will be between an orange flag on the portside of the race committee boat at the starboard end of the line and the orange float at the port-end.
- 11.2 The finish line is opened.

#### 12 PENALTY SYSTEM

**12.1** The penalties are as follows: In accordance with *The 2005-2008 Racing Rules of Sailing*.

#### 13 TIME LIMITS

**13.1** No Time Limits

#### 14 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 14.1 Protests shall be written on forms available at NJYC and delivered there within 45 minutes after the race committee boat has docked. Protests will be heard in the approximate order of receipt, as soon as possible.
- Protests notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board within 30 minutes following the protest time limit.

#### 15 SCORING

15.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low point system.

#### 16 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- **16.1** Check-out and check-in: With the race committee.
- A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible VHF channel 68.

#### 17 OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be marked as follows: race committee boat RC flag, Safety boat orange and white checkered flag.

#### 18 PRIZES

**18.1** Prizes will be given as follows: First, Second and Third Place "Battle Flags" in all Classes.

#### 19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

19.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 20 INSURANCE

**20.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
