NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- **1.1** The Interclub Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The US SAILING prescriptions will apply.
- **1.3** The PHRF rules of the First Coast Sailing Association (FCSA) will apply.
- 1.4 Racing Rule 44.2 is modified to require only one 360 degree turn including one tack and one jibe vice two.

2. ADVERTISING – Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to two FCSA PHRF rated boats from each participating member club. One boat will be a non-spinnaker boat and the other boat will be a spinnaker boat.
- **3.2** The skipper of each entry must be a member of the club that the entry represents. The others may be club members or spouses/family of club members but are not restricted.
- **3.3** Entry Clubs may register by completing the enclosed Regatta Entry Form. This form is also available on the FCSA Web Site at <u>www.sailjax.com</u>. The first two classes listed apply for this regatta.
- **3.4** Each entry club will provide one member for the race committee. Navy Jacksonville Yacht Club will provide the Principal Race Officer.

- 7. NUMBER OF RACES Three races are scheduled. One race constitutes a series. There will be no excluded races.
- **8. VENUE** The racing area will be in the St. Johns River as depicted on NOAA Chart 11492 between the Buckman Bridge to the south and the Fuller Warren Bridge to the north.
- 9. COURSES The course will be contained in the Sailing Instructions
- **10. SCORING** Spinnaker and non-spinnaker boats will be scored as separate classes. The club with the lowest aggregate score will win the regatta.
- **11. PRIZES** -- The FCSA Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the first place club, to be displayed at their club for the year.

12. BASE PASSES

- **12.1** A NJYC representative will be at the Yorktown Gate (main gate) from 9:00 to 10:00 AM the day of the race to help with base entrance. All <u>persons</u> entering the base must have a picture ID. All vehicles must have and provide proof of current registration and insurance.
