
Wednesday Night Beer Can Series 2010

NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. RULES: This series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing and the "Golden Rule"
- 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:
 - **2.1.** The races are open to all boats of all classes.
 - **2.2.** PHRF rating certificate is definitely not required.
 - **2.3.** All participants are expected to relax, have fun and enjoy one's favorite beverage.
- 3. SCHEDULE: Schedule of Events for each Race Date:
 - 3.1. Registration: None.
 - **3.2.** Competitors Meeting: None.
 - 3.3. Warning Signal for all Classes: 6:25
 - 3.4. Number of Races: There will be one race for all 'classes' combined.
- 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: 'Do unto to others . . . ' as described by the "Golden Rule"
- **5. VENUE:** The racing area will be in the St. Johns River between the Buckman Bridge to the South and the Fuller Warren Bridge to the North.
- 6. THE COURSE, START and FINISH:
 - **6.1.** Race course shall be announced at Mark E by the Race Committee boat.
 - **6.2.** There will be a standard five-minute start sequence (so boats may get practice for "real" racing).
 - 6.3. Finish at Mark E
- 7. **SCORING:** First one over the line wins bragging rights.
- **8. PARTY & COOK OUT** at The Rudder Club following racing. Hamburgers and hotdogs provided *gratis* by The Rudder Club. Participants are encouraged to bring a side dish to share.
- 9. PARTICIPATION/LIABILITY DISCLAIMER: Sailing is a sport that has an inherent risk of injury and property damage. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, host club) will not be responsible for any injury to any competitor, including death, or for damage to any boat or personal property sustained as a result of participation in this event.
