## 2025 Father's Day Regatta

### Notice of Race

#### 1 Eligibly and Entry

- 2.1 All sailboats as defined in FCSA PHRF Rules and FCSA Bylaws.
- 2.2 At the discretion of the Race Committee, provisional ratings may be given, while ratings are being processed by FCSA.

#### 2 Fees

- 2.1 Entry Fee will be \$60.00 for PHRF fleet and \$25 for Dinghy Fleet inclusive of tax for the regatta, payment must be received prior to racing. SAYC Members may charge their house account. Entries close at 0900 am on June 15, 2025

#### 3 Schedule – Sunday June 15, 2025

- 3.1 0900 Skippers meeting at St. Augustine Yacht Club
- 1055 Warning signal for the first race will be at 1055 (start at 1100)
- 1200 Anchor party and lunch from 1200 to 1345 (approximate). Boats are responsible for bringing their own lunches and libations
- 1355 Warning signal for the second race will be at 1355 (start 1400)
- 1700 Awards party and Father's Day BBQ at SAYC

#### 4 Sailing Instructions & Classes

- 4.1 Classes will be Performance, Cruising and Dinghy
- 4.2 Spinnaker/non-spinnaker must be declared to SAYC RCoS (below) prior to racing.
- 4.3 Sailing Instructions will be available at the skippers meeting and online

#### 5 Venue & Courses

- 5.1 North of the Vilano Bridge in the Tolomato River, St. Augustine
- 5.2 Race 1 will start between committee boat displaying an orange flag and day Mark #55 and proceed northward towards day mark #44. The finish line shall be between an orange flag on the committee boat and day mark #44
- 5.3 There will be a lunch break and swim call prior to race 2
- 5.4 Race 2 will start between the committee boat displaying an orange flag and day mark #44 and proceed southerly toward day mark #55. The finish line shall be between an orange flag on the committee boat and day mark #55

#### 6 Prizes

- 6.1 Results will be announced at SAYC at the Father's day BBQ and party.

#### 7. Disclaimer of Liability

- 8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 8 Insurance

- 8.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$250,000 per incident or the equivalent.

#### 9 SAYC Associate Membership

- 7.1 A portion of the non-member skipper's registration fee will pay for and grant a SAYC Associate Membership of the skipper for the duration of events hosted at the SAYC, that are directly related to this race. By registering for this event and attending any related event hosted at the SAYC clubhouse, skippers (non-member or otherwise) acknowledge that they are responsible for the conduct of their guests (the SAYC Code of Conduct may be found on the notice board inside the clubhouse) and any debt that their guests may incur.
