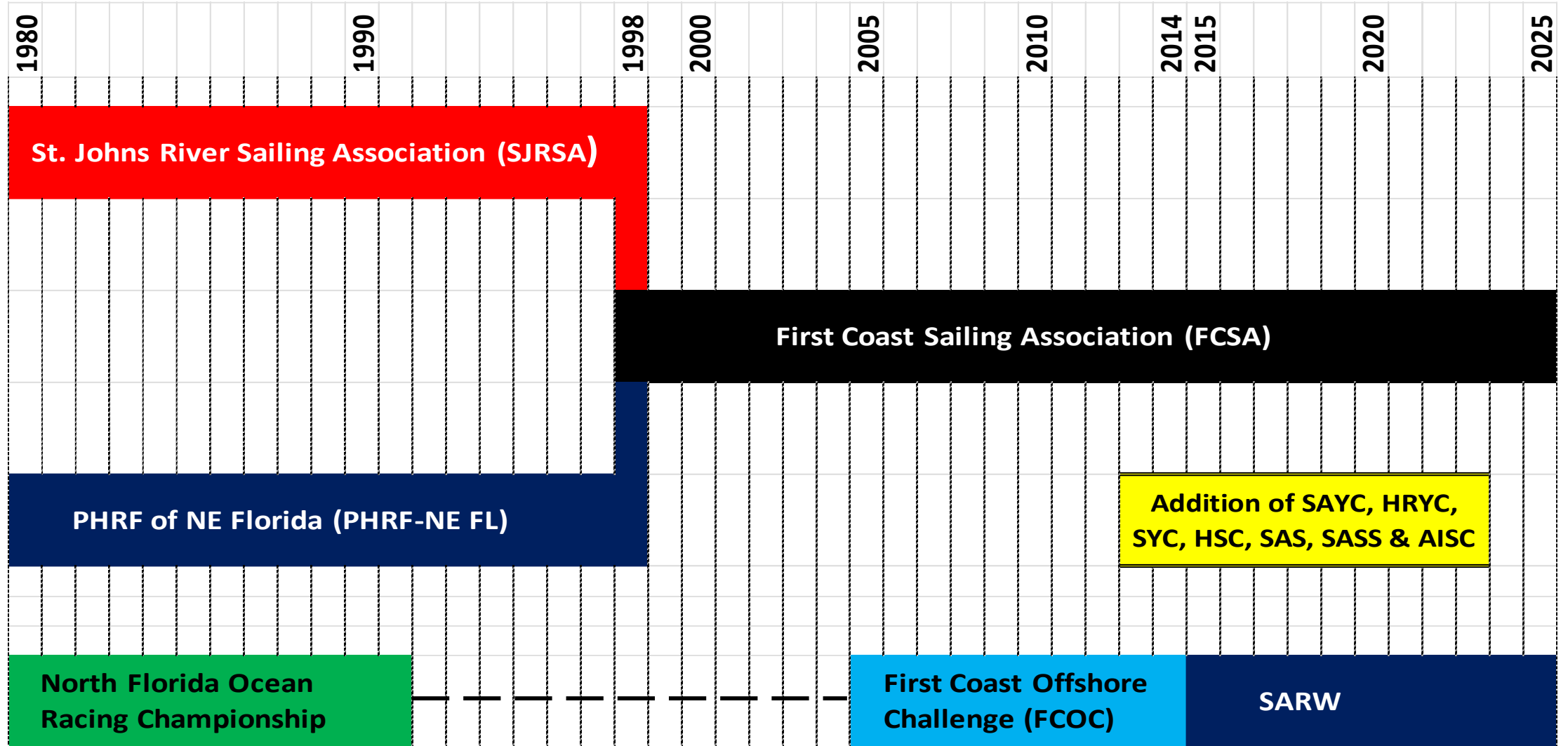
Our By-Laws, PHRF Rules, Race Management Guidelines, and Operating Procedures have required an immense amount of work the past two years to address the needs of our expanded area.

# Opening Comments

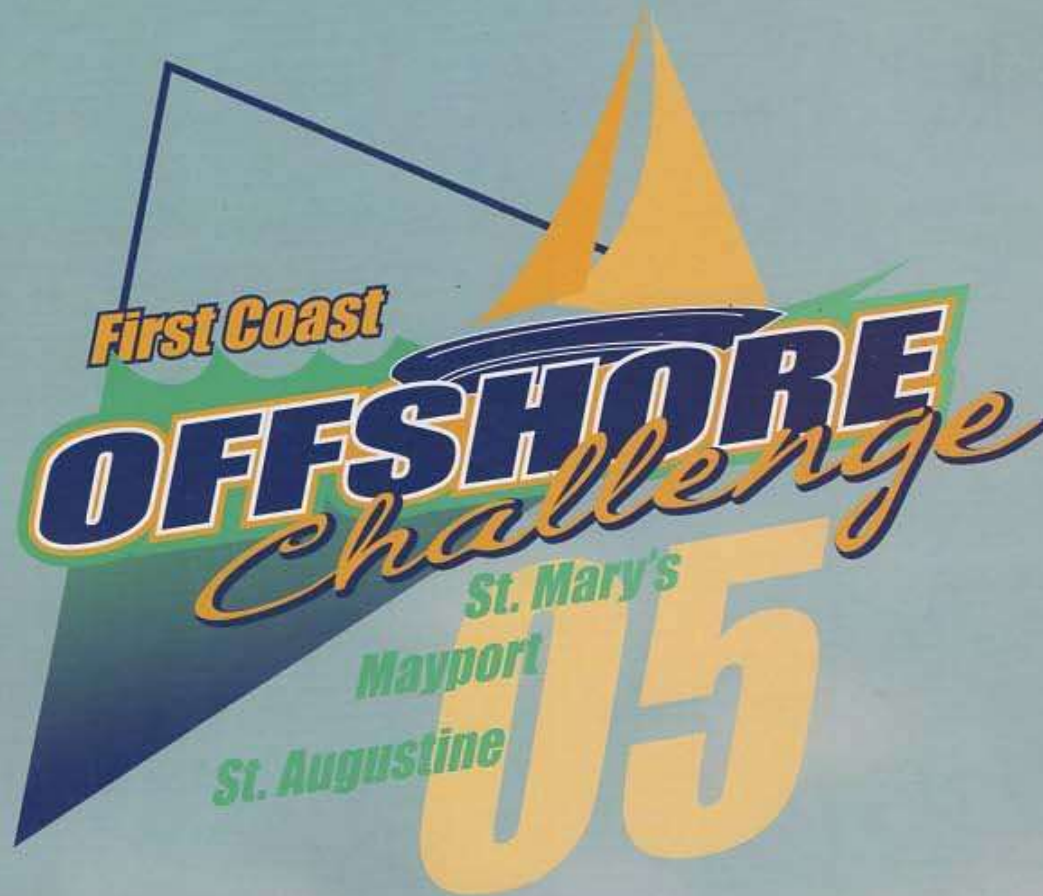
To understand the needs and priorities of an organization that has promoted and governed local area PHRF racing for the past 45 years, it is important to understand how we got here and the changing needs of our organization.

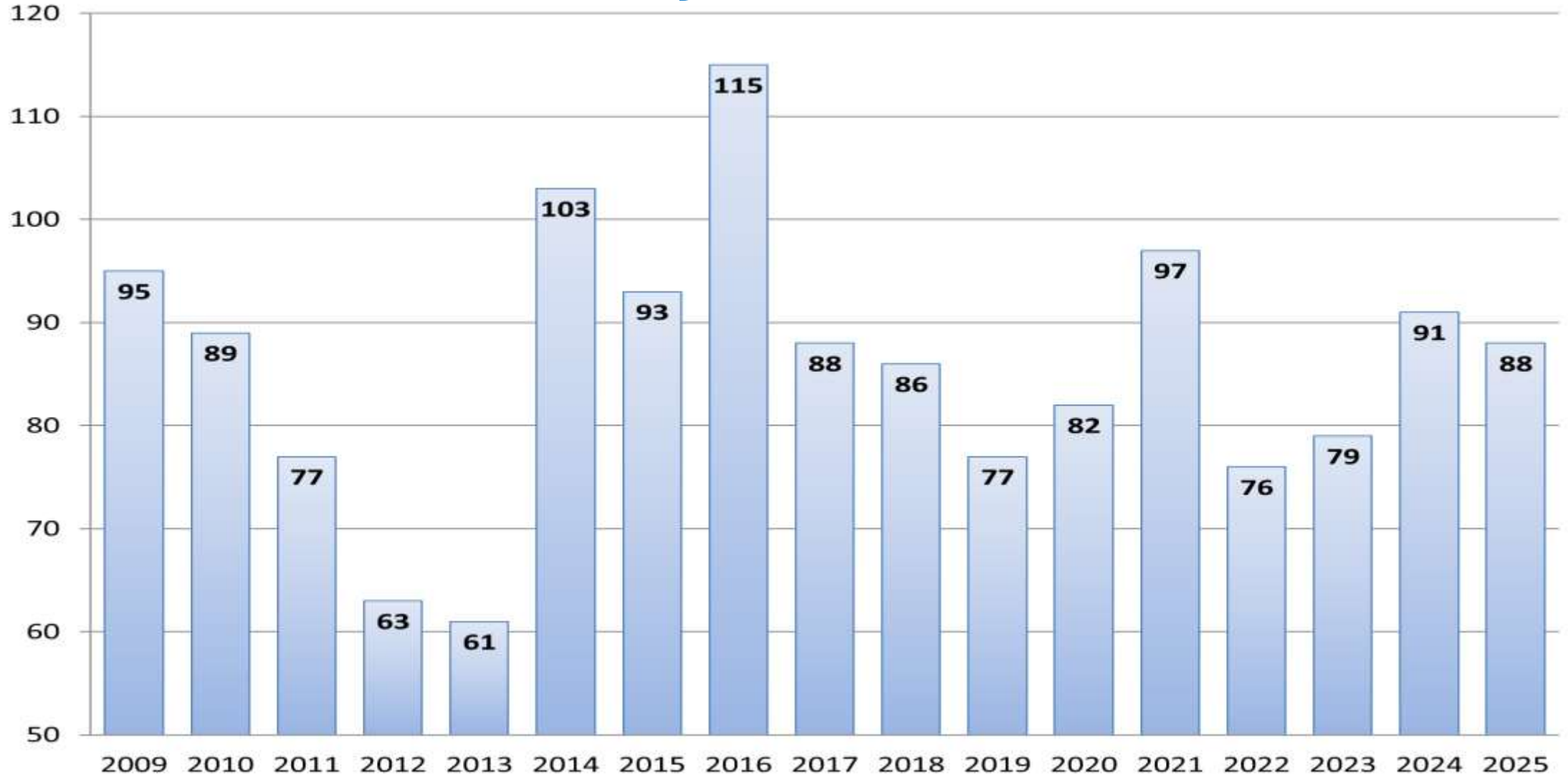

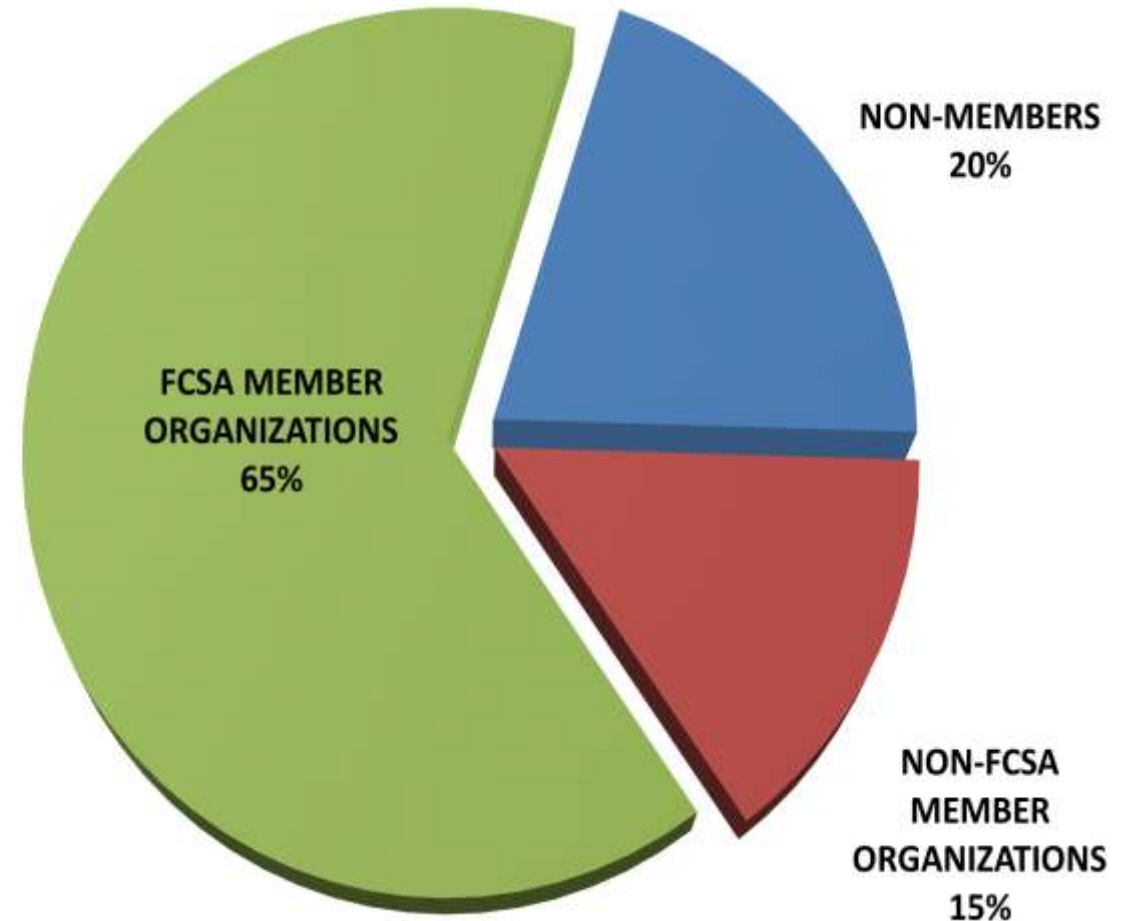
# PHRF Certificates by Year



# Certificates FCSA Members vs. Non-Members

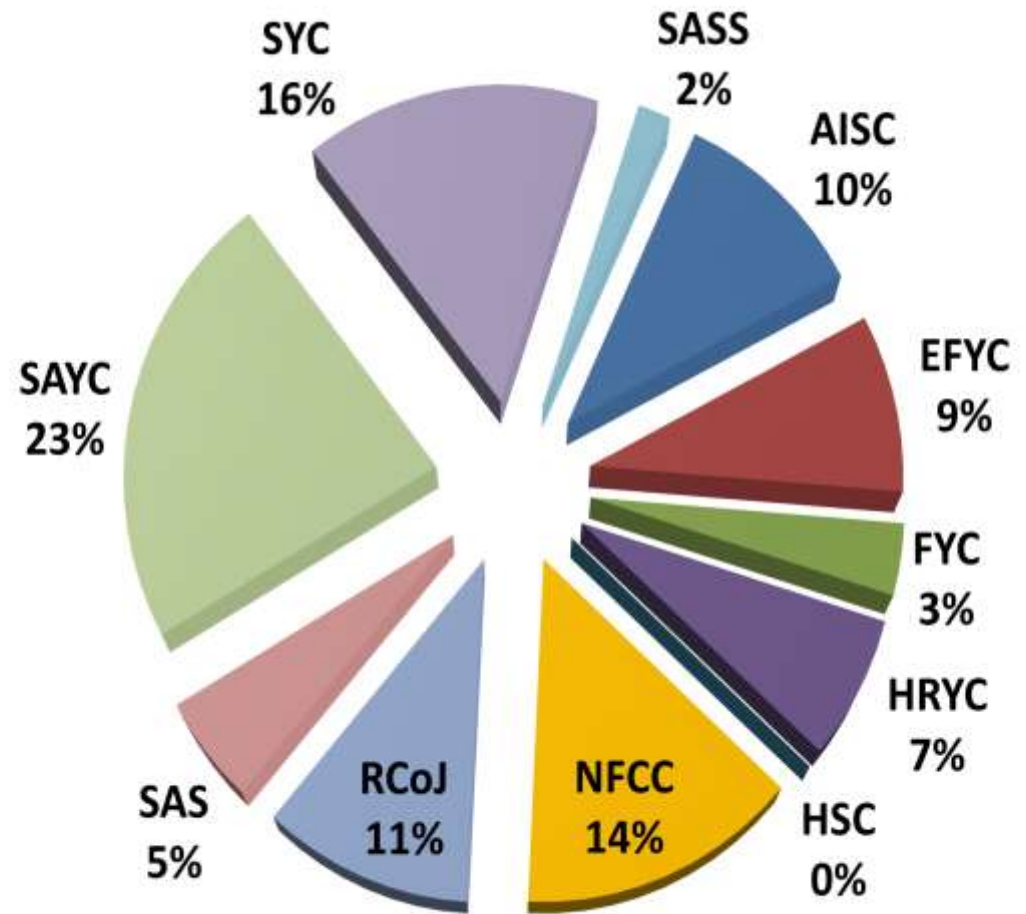
Only 65% of our total roster of PHRF Certificates are based in our Member Organizations

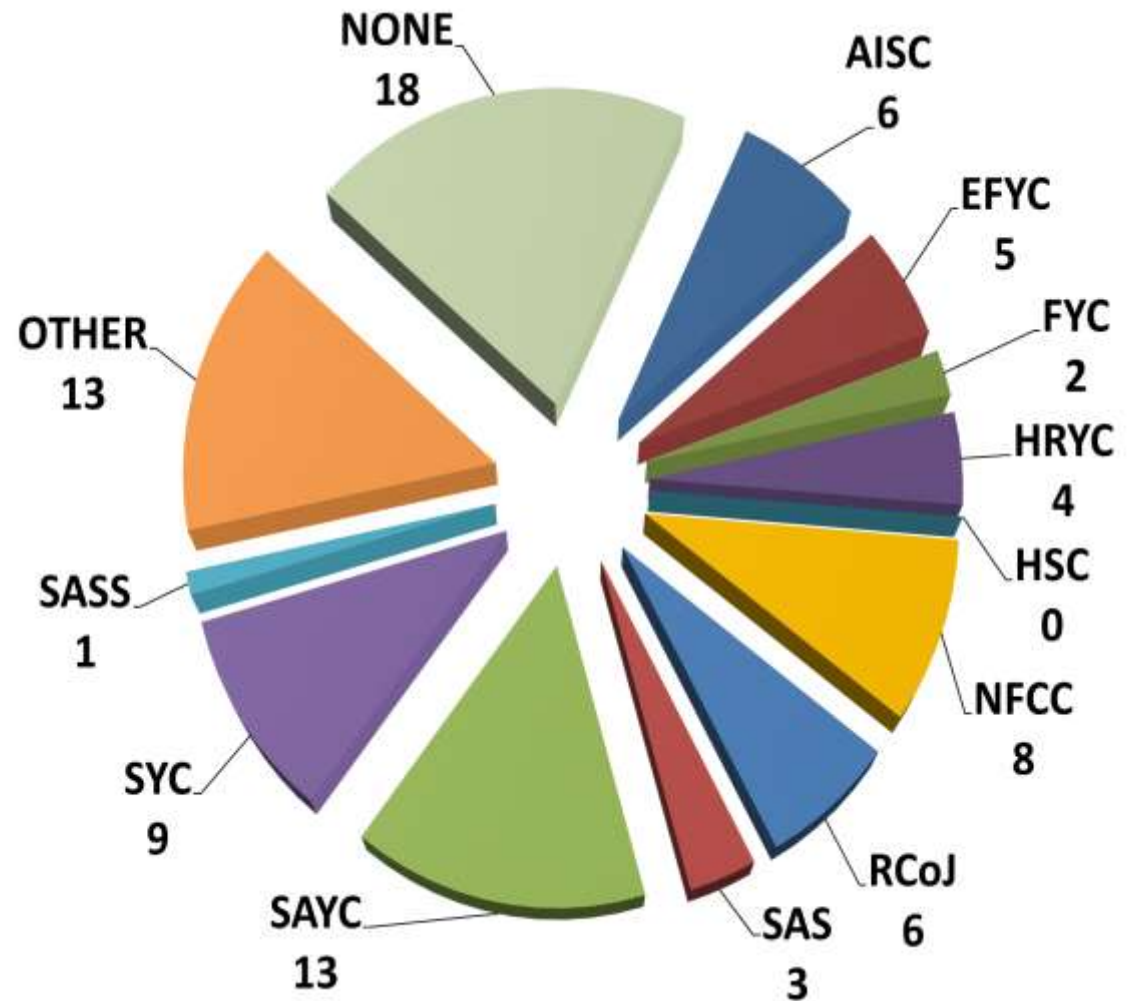

It is interesting to note that the number of boats not associated with any sailing organization exceeds our largest Member Organization (SAYC) by 138%.

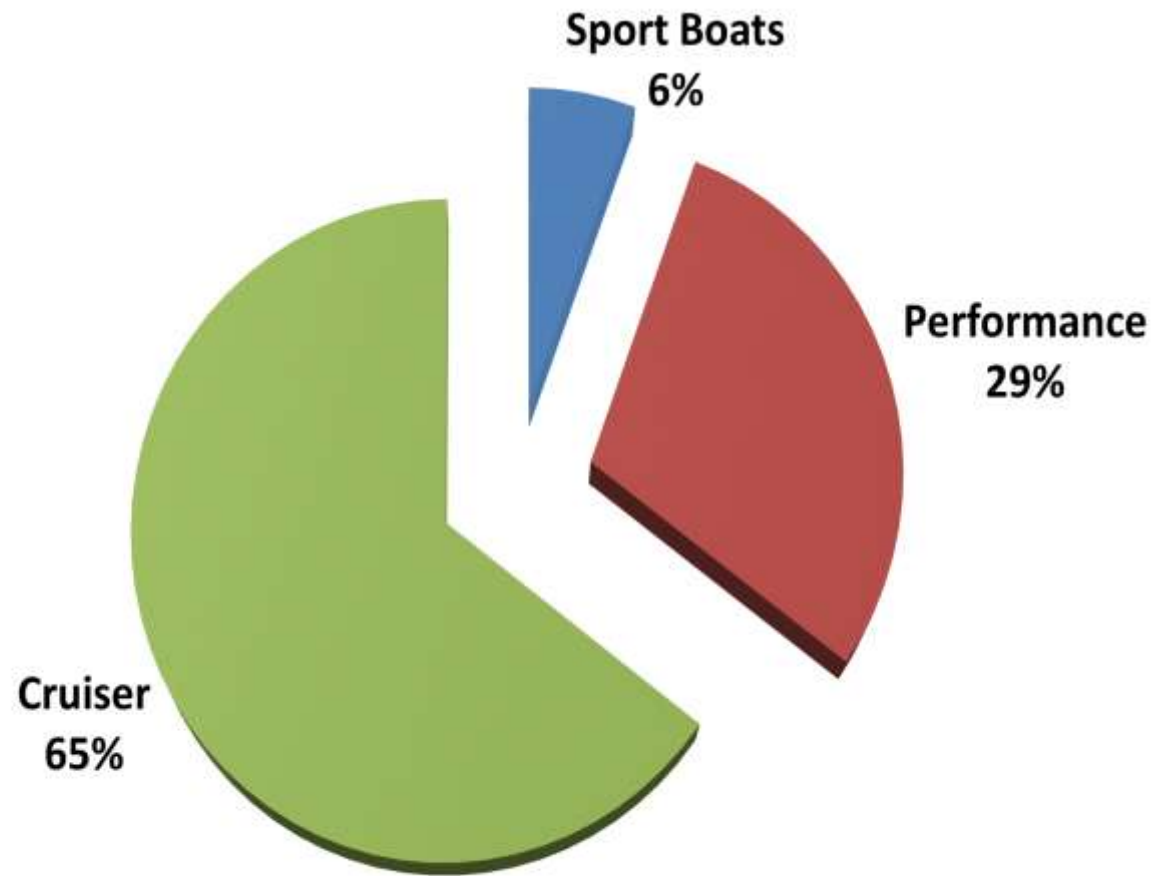
Also note, the number of boats from organizations outside our area, like MYC and CORA, are equal to the number in our largest Member Organization.



## Certificates by Classification

The Cruiser Class has grown to a very active offshore class of both spinnaker and non-spinnaker boats.

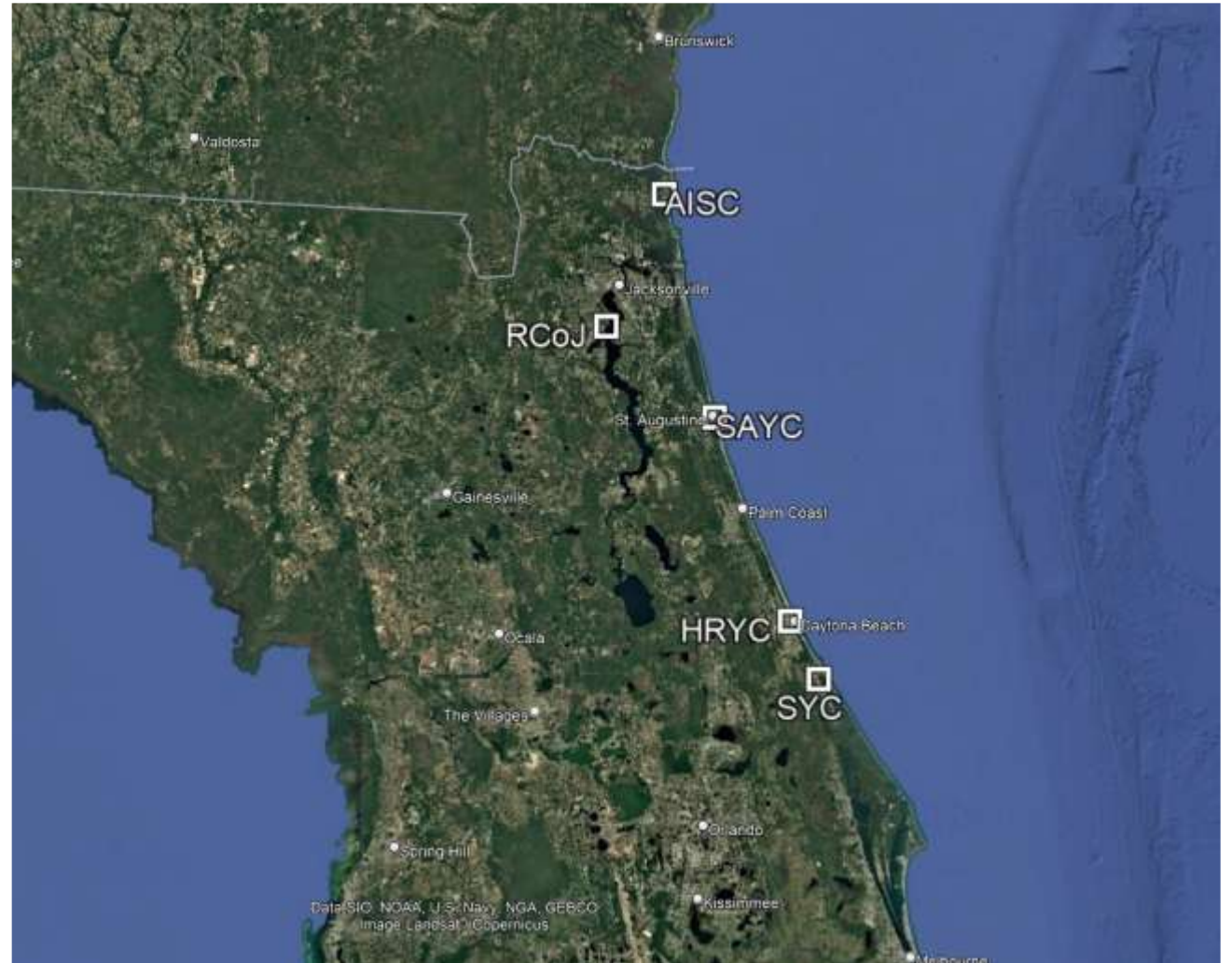
Currently with the small number of Sport Boats, most racing events in recent years have combined Sport Boats and Performance boats as a single Performance Class.



## Expansion of Member Organizations

Despite general decline in participation in our sport, the addition of seven organizations to FCSA since 2013 has supported the continued function of FCSA.

However, this expansion has caused some challenges, resulting in the need to update our By-Laws, PHRF Rules, and improve our operating procedures.



## The Reality of Current Trends

The center of our organization has shifted to St. Augustine.

Our organization, once predominantly performance racers on the St Johns River, has expanded to a wider area with 65% Cruiser boats.

Future leadership of FCSA needs to come from all our Member Organizations.



# 2025 Year in Review

## Achievements

We had what could be called the best SARW ever.

We supported 27 youth sailors at Youth Sailing Camps and Youth Sailing Teams, \$14,595 awarded in Youth Scholarships.

We made substantial progress in completing our FCSA procedures.

We did a major cleanup of the PHRF Rules.

We issued a new document, Race Management Guidelines and conducted a one-day training session last August 2nd.

## Challenges

We need members to step forward and take leadership positions in FCSA.

Two of the four Member Organizations on the St Johns River ceased to support PHRF races, resulting in low turnout in the St Johns River Series.

On the St Johns River, we have no leadership in Women's Racing and only one low-attended Women's Race.

Maintaining the number of Certificates in the PHRF Roster is challenging. Member Organizations are allowing boats with expired or no certification to race.



# Update of the PHRF Rules – Revision 8

FCSA provides rules and guidelines for participation in FCSA PHRF races.

- PHRF Rules are used to assign PHRF handicaps to boats and to govern the use of these handicaps by Member Organizations in sponsored Races and Regattas that are promoted by FCSA in its Annual Schedule.
- FCSA also provides additional guidelines (Guidelines for Race Committees) not contained in this document for use by Member Organizations in race management that are also available on the FCSA website.

# Race Management Guidelines and Seminar

The Race Management Guidelines is a presentation that is aimed at a full day-long seminar for new race committee personnel and as a refresher for experienced race committees.

The seminar is tailored to contain topics applicable to inshore and offshore PHRF racing that is typical in our area.

# Challenge: Declining Participation

Two of the four Member Organizations on the St Johns River ceased to support PHRF races. This has caused low turnout, in general, in the St Johns River Series.

- Of the nine PHRF races in the St Johns River Series, only five were held and only four were scored.
- Of the four Women's Series races on the St Johns River schedule, only one race was held and scored.
- Three offshore races were cancelled of the 20 event Offshore Series. Fortunately, there are still 17 events remaining in the Offshore Series schedule.

Perpetual trophies for St Johns River Series are suspended until participation improves.

# Solution: Declining Participation

The Rudder Club of Jacksonville runs a spring, summer, and fall series, consisting of six races in each series, 18 races total. The series races are typically one-design classes like Flying Scots as well as mixed classes of Portsmouth monohull and Portsmouth multihull classes.

The Rudder Club of Jacksonville has agreed to add two PHRF races in the spring and two in the fall, in addition to the PHRF races that it already hosts.

These additional PHRF races will make up for the deficit in PHRF racing that we have seen in 2024 and 2025 on the St Johns River.

### **FCSA membership,**

Following are the St. Johns River PHRF races for 2026. Also attached is link to the Rudder Club calendar through the end of 2026.

There are nine races for PHRF boats on the St Johns River in 2026: four in the spring (PHRF Spring Series) and five in the fall (PHRF Fall Series). Seven of these races will be run by the Rudder Club in conjunction with the Spring and Fall Series races. The other two PHRF races will be run by Epping Forest. This is very similar to the calendar the PHRF Fleet has been following for several years. Thanks to the Rudder Club for helping to keep PHRF racing alive on the St. Johns River.

The Women's Series Representative will volunteer for a one-year term.

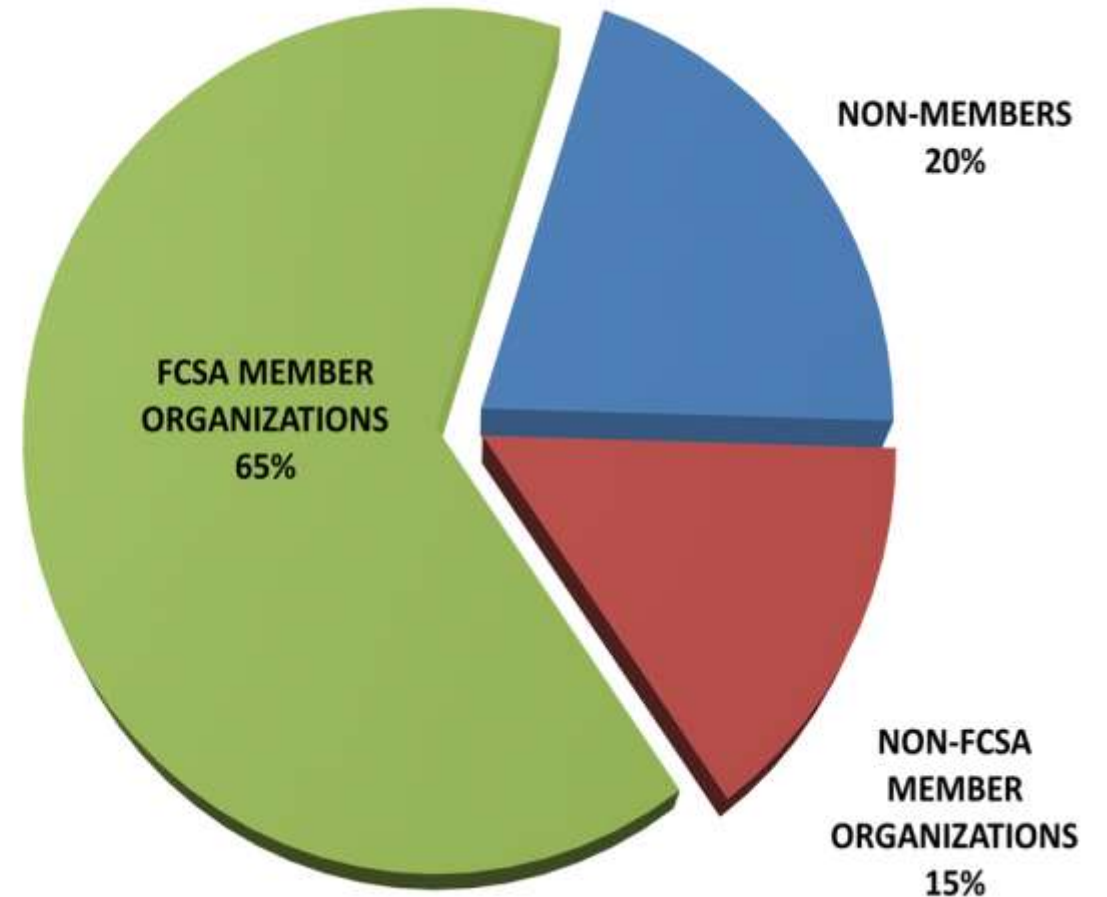
The Women's Series Representative is responsible for the following functions:

- Promoting Women's Series races to the FCSA Certificate Holders
- Compiling results of Women's Series races for computation of Annual Trophies

The Women's Series Representatives will be invited to the regular BOD Meetings of FCSA.

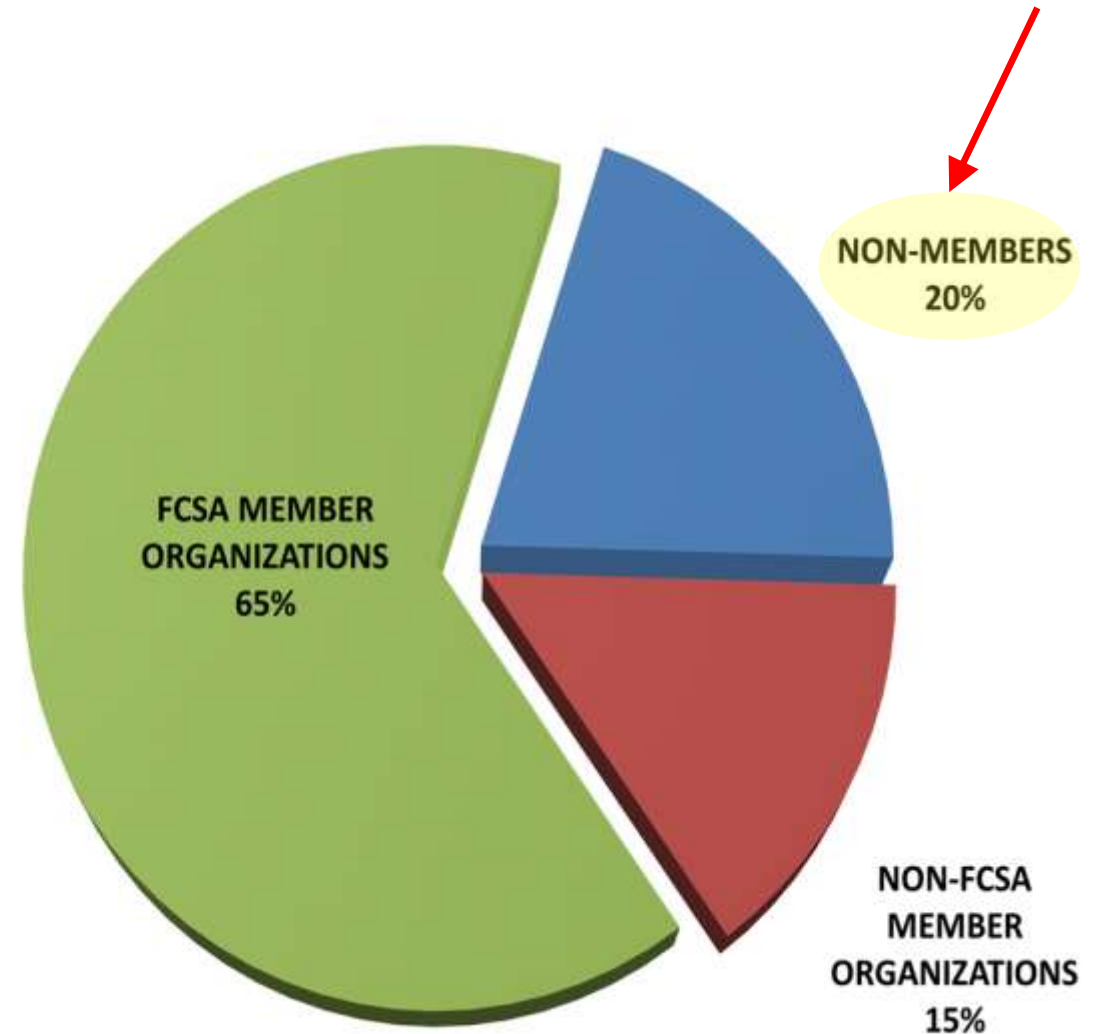

# Solution: Growing the PHRF Roster

We have seen that Member Organizations may allow boats with expired PHRF Certificates or no certification at all to compete in club races and sail for trophies at these events.

- FCSA will not credit the scores of boats not currently certified toward the FCSA Annual Trophies unless they obtain a current certificate by December 1 of that year.
- The primary purpose of the PHRF Roster is to facilitate the Race Committee to obtain and verify the correct handicap to be used for each boat and to verify that each entry has a current PHRF Certificate.
- It is up to each individual club to decide how to handle entries that do not have current PHRF Certificates.

# Note to Race Committees

The purpose of the previous four slides FCSA Website Resources and Understanding the PHRF Roster is to help Race Committees manage the registration of boats in Member Organization sponsored events.

- NORs and SIs should list the RRS and PHRF Rules of FCSA as applicable rules.
- Race Committees should understand and follow the PHRF Rules that pertain to Temporary Ratings and expired PHRF Certificates.
- The latest version of the PHRF Rules is available on the FCSA website and has been revised to clearly define how Temporary Ratings and expired certificates are handled. The following three slides covers these points.

# Temporary PHRF rating

Boats (typically visiting boats) that do not have a FCSA PHRF certificate but have a current certificate with another US Sailing PHRF organization, may apply for a temporary PHRF rating certificate issued by the Chief Rater subject to adjustment(s) under local FCSA rules and base ratings for an administrative fee of \$5.00 payable to FCSA.

Boats applying for a current FCSA Rating would alternately submit the required application and fee.

# Assigning a temporary PHRF rating

A Member Organization may assign a temporary PHRF rating subject to adjustment(s) under local FCSA PHRF Rules and base ratings.

- It is best practice for Member Organizations to require in a race or regatta NOR that all competing boats have current PHRF ratings from FCSA.
- FCSA makes it easy for a boat to obtain a current rating in only a matter of days. If a temporary rating is requested of the Race Committee, it is best practice for the Race Committee to consult with the FCSA Chief Rater, if time allows, or the Member Organization's Rater or Representative so that the temporary rating is fair to all competitors.
- It should also be noted that results for a race or regatta may be subject to revision if, upon review of the Rating Application, the adjusted rating on the rating Certificate is different from the temporary rating.

# PLEASE NOTE!

Boats with expired ratings and boats that have obtained temporary PHRF ratings and have not obtained current FCSA certificate status by December 1 are not eligible for the annual FCSA Series Trophies for that year and subsequent years.

Boats that have obtained temporary PHRF Ratings for all other reasons may use that rating for the rest of the year, subject to the rules of the individual Member Organization(s).

**Temporary ratings cannot be used in subsequent years.**

# Summary of Chairman's Comments

FCSA has remained healthy by expanding its number of Member Organizations and geographic area.

It is important that we maintain the integrity of our system by requiring boats to have current PHRF Certificates.

Prior leadership has come from Jacksonville area Member Organizations because of familiarity with our rating system. We need new leadership to step up from our new Member Organizations.

Our By-Laws, race management guidelines, PHRF Rules, and FCSEA operating procedures have recognized the expansion of our geographic area and growth of the Cruiser Class.

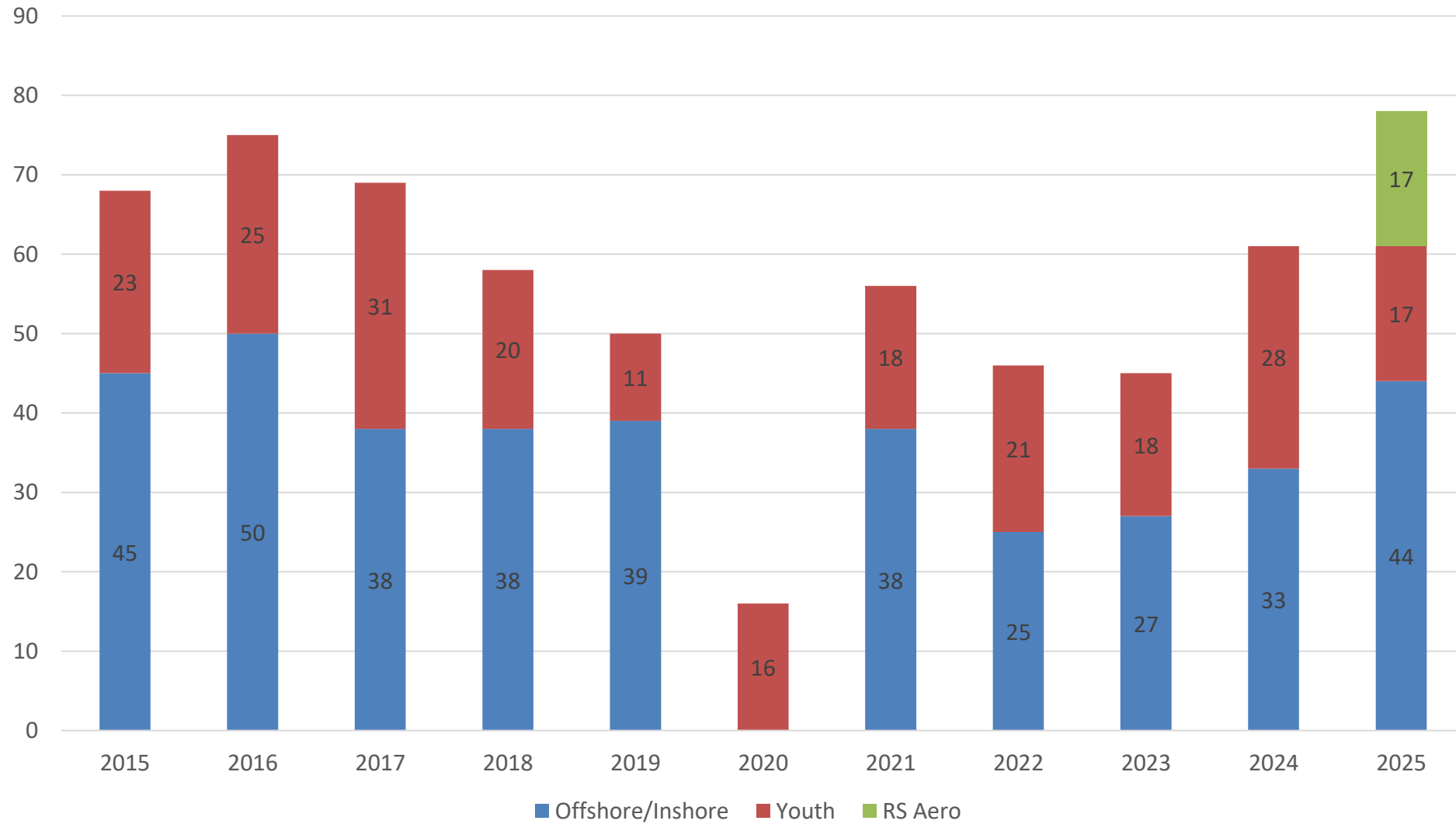

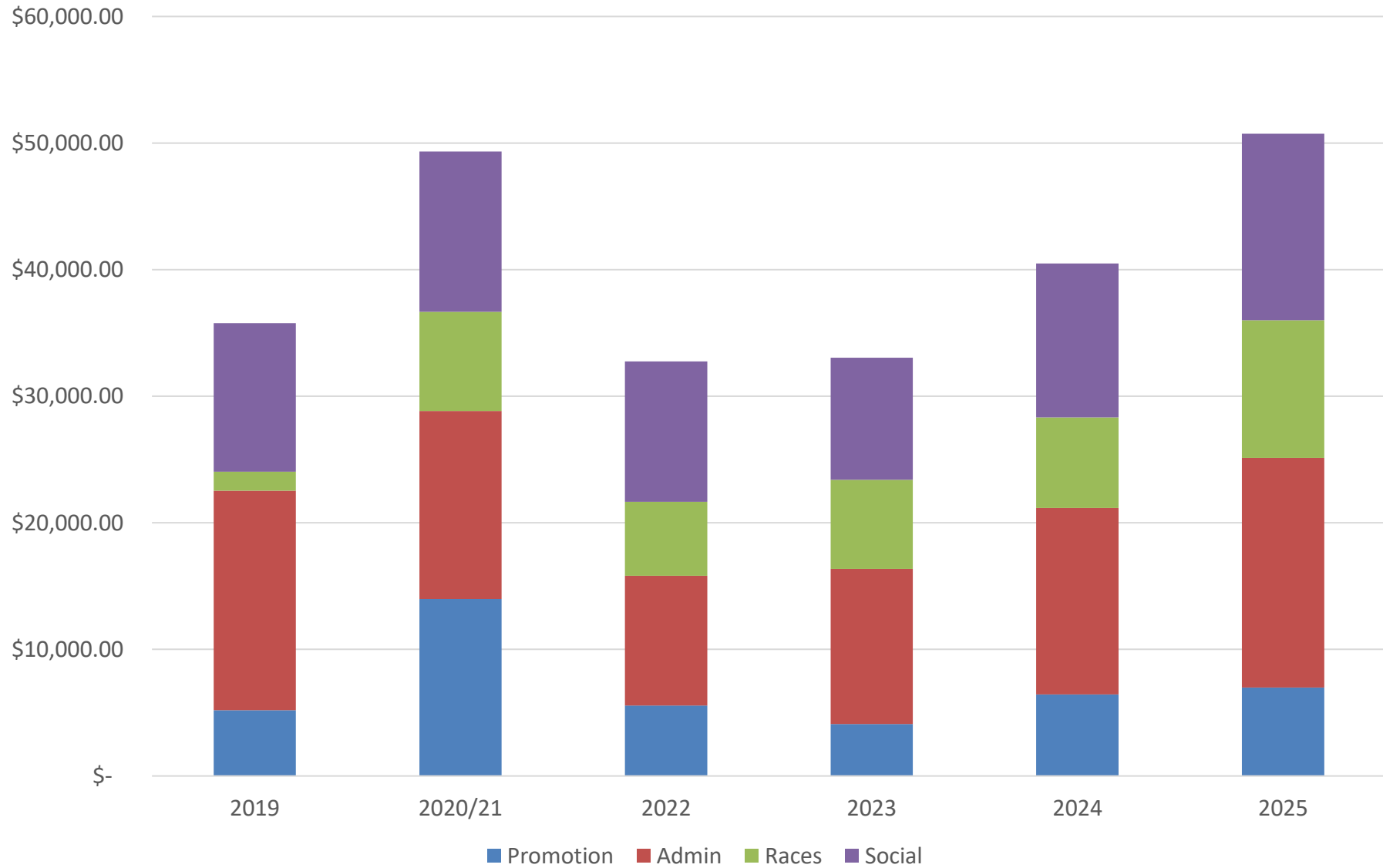

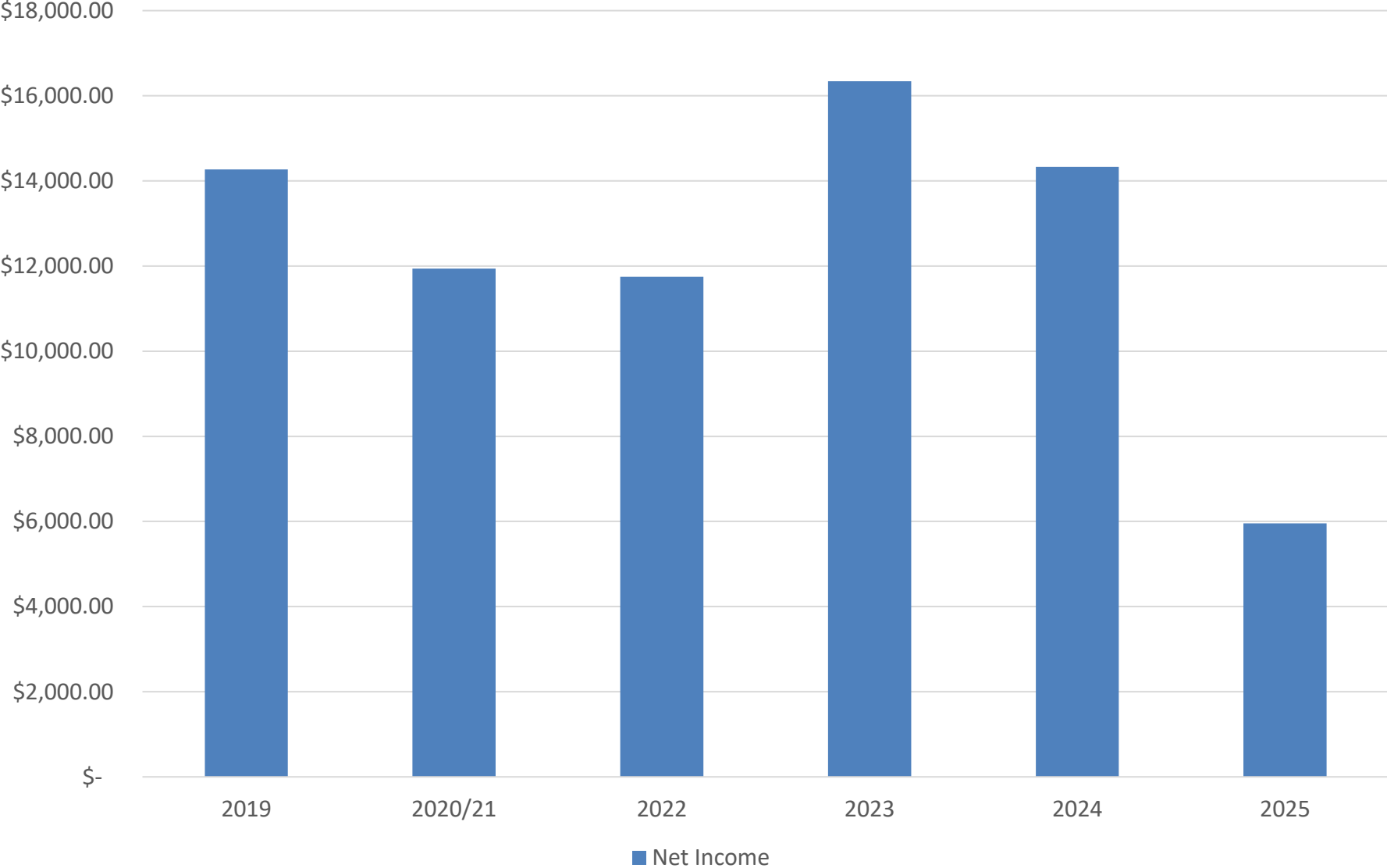
# SARW Gross Revenue History

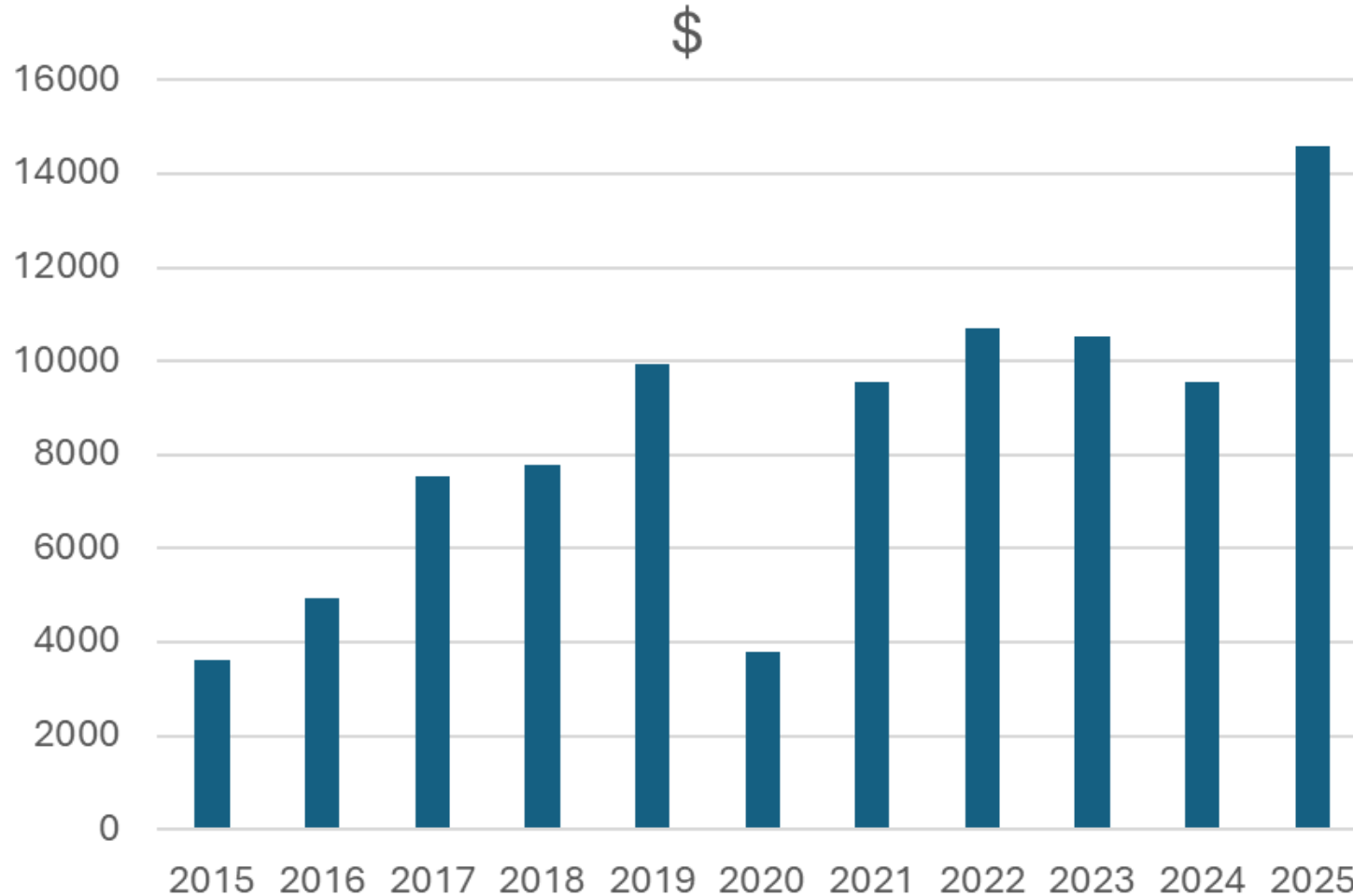

# **Procedure for JDM Youth Sailing Scholarships**

Redrafted 11/18/2025, Revised 12/18/2025

## **Objective and Purpose**

The objective of this procedure is to establish a standardized, transparent, and clearly defined process for administering FCSA allocated funds for Youth Sailing Scholarships. The FCSA Youth Sailing Scholarship program shall be known as the JDM Youth Sailing Scholarship Program. The allocated funds by FCSA shall be known as coming from the JDM Fund.

The purpose of the JDM Fund is to supply Member Organizations with funds for youth sailing programs as defined herein and for no other purpose. The JDM Fund is designed to assist families with Limited Means to enroll their youth in an approved program at one of the participating Member Organizations.

# Checklist for Member Organizations

## STEP 1:

### Provide a written program description

1. Summary of program scope including hours of scheduled classroom and on the water training, and overall schedule showing number of days and duration of training sessions
2. Application process, including sample application form
3. Qualification criteria
4. Record keeping forms to be provided, including a simple statement by your organization that each Scholarship Candidate requesting financial assistance has Limited Means
5. Safety equipment: what is provided and who provides it
6. Items provided by each Youth Sailor

# Checklist for Member Organizations

## STEP 2:

At the end of each sail camp session(s) send a cumulative list of all Scholarship Participant's, names, ages, dates of attendance, requested reimbursement for each Scholarship Participant, a statement that each Scholarship Participant has Limited Means, and a grand total for the invoice.

Provide an invoice on your organization's letterhead, signed by an authorized representative of the Member Organization, and sent to the Youth Sailing Scholarship Chairman.

# Checklist for Member Organizations

## STEP 3:

The Youth Sailing Scholarship Chairman will review and approve all scholarship requests along with supporting documentation.

The Youth Sailing Scholarship Chairman will then forward each Member Organization's approved invoice to the FCSA Board of Directors for final approval.

Following final approval, the Treasurer will follow FCSA procedures and issue a reimbursement check to the Member Organization.

# JDM Youth Sailing Scholarship Applications

In February 2026, the JDM Program Chairman will send a letter in the form of an e-mail and procedure that will guide each Member Organization in making application for scholarships in support of sponsored Youth Sailing programs.

If your Member Organization is contemplating a youth sailing program this year, please let us know and identify your youth sailing contact.

The information will be sent to the Youth Sailing Representative designated by each Member Organization.
